RULES

NOTICES TO COMPETITORS

Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice board located at the West Vancouver Yacht Club

SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

Signals made ashore will be made from the flagpole on the lawn to the West of the main Clubhouse.

SCHEDULE OF RACES

There is both a long and short course. See below. The first warning signal will be made at 1055 hours

RACING AREA

Racing will take place in Howe Sound and the Straight of Georgia.

COURSES

a. Long Course - Divisions 1, 2, and 3: From the start line located in the vicinity of the south end of Passage Island, leaving the Halibut Bank Buoy to port, to the finish line located in the vicinity of the south end of Passage Island. Distance: approximately 33.6 NM.

b. Short Course - Divisions 5, 6, 0 and M242: From the start line located in the vicinity of the south end of Passage Island, leaving a mark positioned south west of Popham Island to port, to a finish line located in the vicinity of the south end of Passage Island. Distance: approximately 16.9 NM

MARKS

TIME LIMIT

a. Long Course - The Time Limit will be 2200 hours

b. Short Course - The Time Limit will be 1800 hours

PROTESTS

a. The protest time limit will be 1 hour after Race Committee boat docks. The exact time shall be posted on the official notice board.

b. Protests should be filed at the front desk of the WVYC Club House within the time limit posted.

PRIZES

a. Prizes may be awarded following racing at a Social at the WVYC Club House.

b. All efforts will be made to accommodate visiting yachts during the Social.
